

CHECKLIST: BASIC MAINTENANCE OF MACHINE

It is very important to check your machine regularly in order to detect and prevent wear, damage, etc. Always make sure that the machine is lubricated and maintained according to the operating instructions, and follow the instructions below with the checkpoints that apply to your machine.

Service intervals: Go through the machine according to the checklist

- New machine – Before first use, check according to the checklist. After 2 hours, check and tighten all bolts, nuts and connections.
- Before storing the machine at the end of the season: Check according to the checklist, replace or repair any broken or worn parts.

1. Check and tighten all bolts, nuts and connections.				
2. Check that all guards are in place.				
3. Check oil level in gearbox - refill or change oil according to interval.				
4. Check and lubricate all lubrication points.				
5. Check air pressure and that tyres are intact.				
6. Check hydraulic system: oil level, correct oil type, check filter and check for leaks. <i>(Important! Use clean oil in the hydraulic system)</i>				
7. Check that the machine's emergency stop is working.				
8. Check that the drive belts are tensioned and intact – Tension if necessary, replace belts according to the maintenance schedule.				
9. Check that the brakes are working.				
10. Check that all cables and sockets are intact.				
11. Check and replace faulty wear parts.				
12. Check when starting the machine: Noise and vibration.				

Store the machine if possible in a dry place under cover, or cover the machine if it is stored outdoors.
